Title: Lift Equipment Inspector

Job Summary

This job is comprised of on-site inspection of lift equipment as per CSA Standards and provincial occupational health and safety regulations. These inspections are performed using various non-destructive testing techniques including visual, magnetic particle, liquid penetrant, ultrasonic and Brinell hardness testing of materials. This position has a key focus on customer service and preparation of field inspection reports.

- Perform thorough inspection of equipment or related engineering inspection services in a timely manner
- Prepare accurate field inspection report documents in accordance with company report templates
- Maintain effective customer relations through service quality and timeliness of inspection services by addressing customer concerns and involving management as required
- Responsible for the maintenance of assigned vehicle & equipment
- Develop business by maintaining and growing the customer base via sales and marketing efforts that are part of a customer care program in the company
